



DRESS CODE

Camp is all about having fun, staying active, and growing closer to God. So, we've laid out some clear guidelines to keep things respectful, modest, and distraction-free while ensuring everyone feels comfortable.

1 Corinthians 8:12 says, *"Therefore, if what I eat causes my brother to fall into sin, I will never eat meat again, so that I will not cause him to fall"*. While we're not asking you to give up your favorite snacks, or your best friends, we are asking everyone to dress in a way that honors God and respects those around us. Let's rise above the world's trends and represent Christ well!

1. For Everyone: Stay Covered

- Clothing should cover the midriff, chest, back and sides even when lifting hands in worship.
- No crop tops or low-cut shirts.
- Undergarments should remain fully covered and not visible.
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be at least mid-thigh length.
- Leggings, yoga pants, and bike shorts are not permitted as standalone bottoms.

2. Swimwear:

- Guys: Swim shorts that are at least mid-thigh.
- Girls: One-piece swimsuits with full coverage. No high-cut or thong styles.
- Campers must wear a cover-up or shirt when transitioning between activities.

3. Graphics and Messages:

- Avoid clothing with offensive, inappropriate, or suggestive images or text.

4. Footwear:

- Closed-toe shoes are required for physical activities.
- Sandals and flip-flops are fine for casual and water-related activities.

5. Special Activities:

- Some activities may have specific dress requirements for safety or comfort.
- We'll let you know ahead of time, and we ask students to comply.

Enforcement:

Our goal isn't to embarrass anyone but to maintain a safe, Christ-honoring environment for everyone. If there's a dress code concern, our camp staff will address it privately and respectfully. Students may be asked to change into something more appropriate from their belongings or something provided by the camp.
